Vanadium pentoxide is poisonous by ingestion and inhalation as well as other routes. Ingestion causes disturbances of the gastrointestinal tract. May also cause a papular skin rash. Vanadium pentoxide is a respiratory irritant. Effects include skin pallor, greenish-black tongue, chest pain, cough, dyspnea, palpitation and lung changes. Causes reproductive and mutagenic effects in laboratory animals.
